

Hostile Environment Security Awareness

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is aimed at providing delegate with the knowledge and skills of surviving critical situations, and to take care of their own safety in high-risk areas. It also provides delegates with knowledge and skills to lower potential risks and cope with threats, injuries, hostage taking, terrorist attacks as well as armed conflicts.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is suitable for humanitarian aid workers, human right defenders, freelance journalist and others who have been deployed to hostile environment and remote areas as well as anyone who seeks to have an in-depth understanding of hostile environment security awareness.

COURSE OUTCOMES

Delegates will gain the knowledge and skills to:

- Identify significant threat to personal safety.
- Develop personal security and awareness technologies to mitigate risks.
- Provide life-saving and immediate medical care in hostile and challenging environment.
- Effectively plan and prepare assignments in potentially hostile and remote environment.
- Understand the need to analyze situation ahead of time.
- Understand and utilize field communication equipment.
