

Monitoring and Evaluation of Projects

COURSE OVERVIEW

With an increasing need for accountability, results-based management, and evidence-driven decision-making, strong M&E systems have become essential for public, private, and development sector projects.

Delegates will learn how to set performance indicators, measure outcomes, use data collection methods, and apply evaluation techniques to improve project planning, delivery, and impact.
