

Driving Performance through Enhanced Strategic and Financial Planning

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course introduces strategic financial planning and its practical applications to situations that are typical for someone at the senior management level. Delegates will be equipped to make strategic decisions and cooperate with accounting or financial experts to achieve organizational objectives.
