The updated framework features a Core Model with 40 governance and management objectives, enhanced performance measurement through maturity and capability models, and adaptable design factors for flexible implementation. Originally focused on IT audit, COBIT now supports enterprise-wide governance. This Foundation course introduces key concepts, principles, governance components, objectives, performance management, and how to design tailored governance systems for various business needs.
