

ISO 45001 Lead Implementer – Occupational Health and Safety Management System

After completing the course, you'll take a certification exam. Successful candidates can apply for the IAS-accredited "PECB Certified ISO 45001 Lead Implementer" credential, which confirms your ability to implement an OH&S MS based on ISO 45001 standards.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The ISO 45001 Lead Implementer training course is intended for individuals responsible for maintaining and improving workplace safety, including occupational health and safety officers, consultants, and advisors. It is also suitable for professionals seeking to understand PECB's IMS2 Methodology for implementing an OH&S management system, those tasked with ensuring conformity to ISO 45001 requirements, members of OH&S teams, and individuals aiming to build a career as OH&S MS implementers, consultants, or officers.
