

Scaled Scrum Product Owner Certified (SSPOC™)

COURSE OVERVIEW

Scrum is a widely used agile methodology known for its adaptability, flexibility, and effectiveness in delivering value quickly throughout a project. The Chief Product Owner handles day-to-day business decisions in large projects with multiple Scrum Teams and Product Owners, overseeing the Prioritized Product Backlog and coordinating work across teams. This role also involves collaborating with the Chief Scrum Master and other Product Owners to identify common resources and components needed throughout the project. Upon passing the certification exam, applicants receive the Scaled Scrum Product Owner Certified (SSPOC™) certificate from SCRUMstudy.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is appropriate for professionals interested in obtaining a working knowledge of Scrum and planning to become a Chief Product Owner, or Program Product Owner, or Portfolio Product Owner.
