

Procurement Law, Risk, and Contract Governance

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course analyzes the legal, regulatory, and governance frameworks that shape procurement practices, ensuring compliance, accountability, and value protection. Procurement law establishes the rules governing sourcing and contracts, risk management safeguards organizations from financial and reputational exposure, and contract governance provides oversight to ensure agreements are ethical, transparent, and enforceable. The course will equip participants with the knowledge and required tools to manage procurement risks, draft and negotiate robust contracts, and apply governance structures that promote fairness, integrity, and sustainable business outcomes.
