

## Joint Operations Planning for Inter-Agency Counter-Terrorism Response

### COURSE OVERVIEW

This course provides a comprehensive framework for understanding and executing joint operations planning in the context of inter-agency counter-terrorism response. The curriculum covers how to design and implement unified response strategies that maximize the strengths of each stakeholder while minimizing overlap and gaps. Key topics include multi-agency command structures, intelligence sharing protocols, crisis communication, resource allocation, and operational logistics. Participants will explore the principles, processes, and coordination mechanisms required to integrate military, law enforcement, intelligence, and civilian efforts in preventing, responding to, and recovering from terrorist threats.

### WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The course is designed for mid to senior level professionals from defense, law enforcement, intelligence, emergency management, and government policy agencies, as well as international and regional organizations involved in counter-terrorism operations. It is particularly suited for officers and managers responsible for operational planning, inter-agency coordination, and decision-making.

- Enhance the ability to design and evaluate integrated counter-terrorism response plans.
